Science: Knowledge of any kind

Catastrophism: Geology the theory that changes in the earth's crust during geological history have resulted chiefly from sudden violent and unusual events.

Consistent Biblical Creation Worldview:

- all-powerful, all-knowing, triune God (Matt. 19:26, Col 2:3, Isaiah 45:5, John 8:18)
- 6 ordinary days (Ex 20:11)
- upholds the universe by His power (Heb 1:3)
- uses logical and consistent methods: laws of nature and science (Jer. 33:25)
- paradise (Gen 2:2)
- animals and plants created in kinds (Gen 1:11, 21, 25)
- Adam given charge (Gen 1:28, 2:15)
- rebellion/judgement by God (curse) (Gen 2:16, 3:6, 3:14–19, Rom 5:12, 8:21–22)
- descendants of Adam (Acts 17:26)
- Flood for judgement (Gen 6:5–7,17)
- Noah/family and the animals (Gen 6:9,18)
- Most fossils are a result of the flood
- God became man (John 1:1, 14)
- took our place (Romans 10:9–10)

uniformitarianism – the theory that changes in the earth's crust during geological history have resulted from the action of continuous and uniform processes. Often contrasted with catastrophism.

Evolutionist Worldview:

Naturalism – the philosophical belief that everything arises from natural properties and causes, and supernatural or spiritual explanations are excluded or discounted, **another term for natural religion.**






ROCK LAYERS

People and dinosaurs are shown to scale




